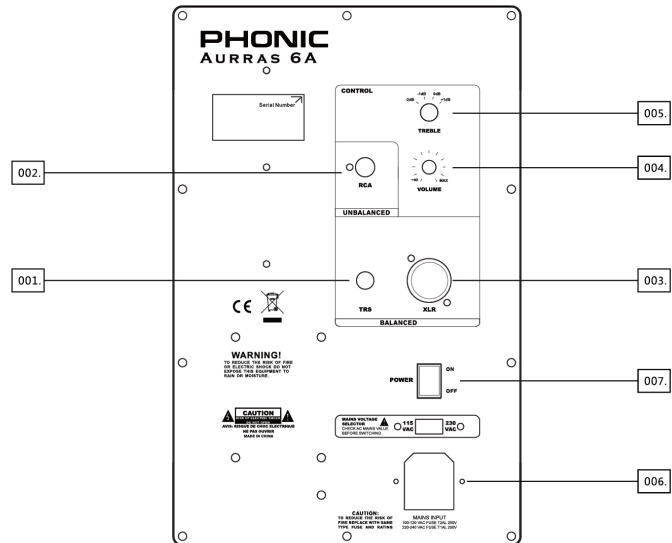

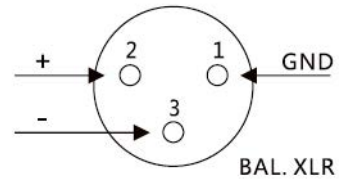

此时你可以连接电源线和信号线，但是在开机之前确保音量调到最小。

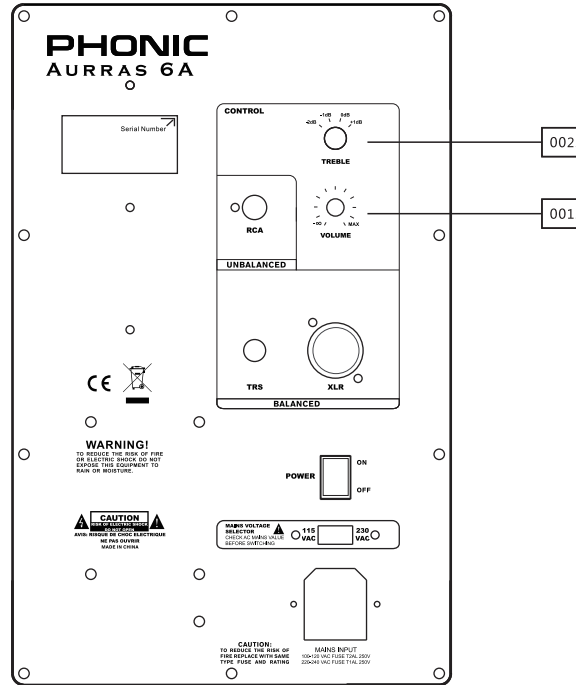
• 开关机顺序：

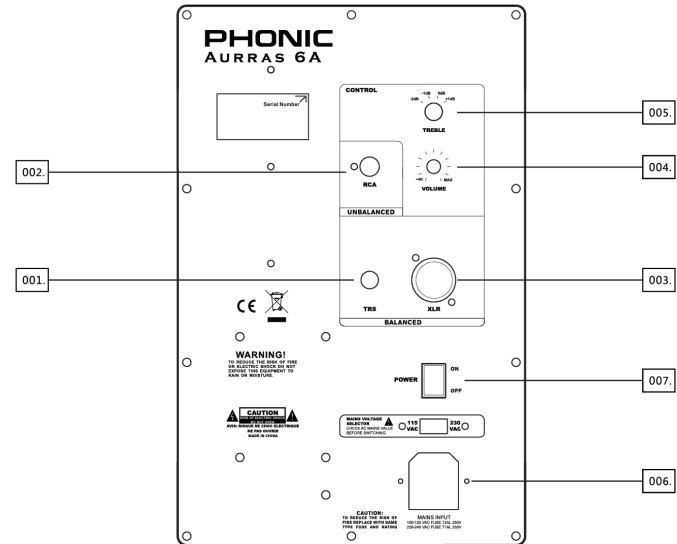

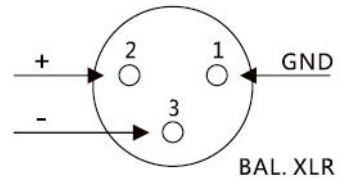

• TURN ON/OFF:

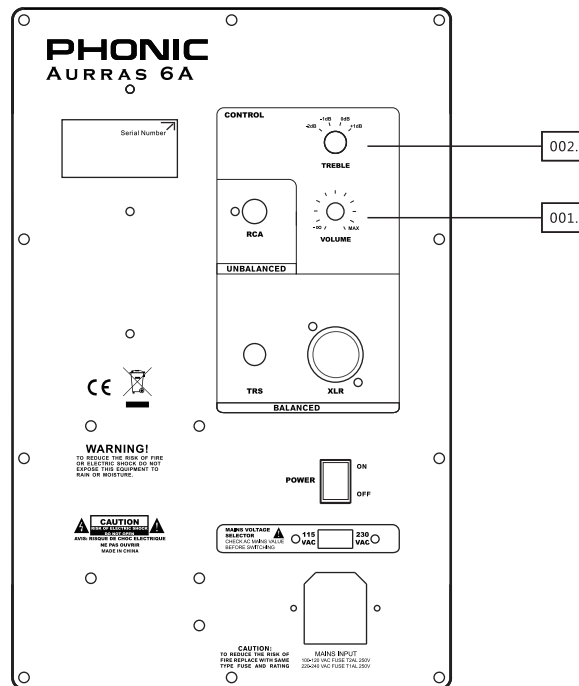
