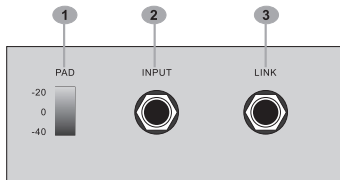

GETTING STARTED

- 1 Install a 9V battery by opening the cover.
- 2 Connect your source into DB2 by a 1/4" mono jack.
- 3 Turn down the input channel fader before connecting DB2 to your mixer by a balanced XLR connector through the output jack.
- 4 Connect DB2 to your guitar amplifier by a 1/4" mono connector through the link out.

CONTROL DESCRIPTION



1 PAD Switch

Use this switch to increase the operating range of DB2. When set at -20dB, the input signal will be attenuated by -20dB; the signal will be reduced by -40dB when you set it at -40dB. A handy design for either electrical guitar or for low level signal of high impedance microphones.

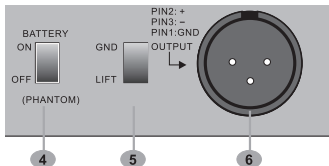
2 INPUT Jack

The input of DB2 accepts 1/4" unbalanced jack.

3 LINK Output

Connect directly to your guitar amplifier or an active speaker with this output.

CONTROL DESCRIPTION



4 BATTERY ON/OFF switch

Powered by 9V battery or phantom power, DB2 leaves the decision to the user. Set it at ON if you want to use the battery; set it at OFF if you wish to use phantom power.

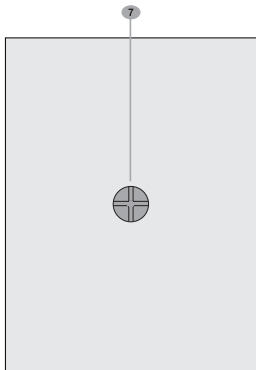
5 GROUND / LIFT Switch

If you set the switch at LIFT, DB2 will automatically break the ground connection between input and output, which would eliminate the ground loops or humming. When setting at GND, the ground connection between input and output will be again connected.

6 OUTPUT

This output accepts balanced XLR female connector, which can be connected to the mic input of your mixer.

7 BATTERY REPLACEMENT

Use a coin to open the cover and install a new battery.
